In this memoir an individual voice adds its power of abiding hope to the volume of human history. On the 1st September 1939, at the age of ten, Ted Baverstock and his classmates at Dawson Junior School became part of a mass evacuation of London's children to the safety of the countryside. The hitherto secret government operation code-named Pied-Piper had begun. School assembly was held in the playground that morning.
